Last day of school moved to May 23

Students in the Pattonville School District will get out of classes three day early this year because the district did not need to use its emergency “snow” days.

Three emergency days were built into this year’s school calendar. Because no emergency days were used to cancel classes during the 2004-2005 school year due to inclement weather, the calendar needed to be revised to subtract three days from the end of the school year for student attendance.

Under the changes, the last day of attendance for students will be May 23. The last day for high school seniors is May 18, with graduation on May 26 at UMB Bank Pavilion. Summer school for high school students will begin June 7, with elementary and middle school summer classes beginning June 13.

If any emergency days are used before the end of the school year, the calendar will be revised accordingly.
