Pattonville students complete construction project

Students in the home construction class at Pattonville High School recently completed a “home improvement” type project at their own school using the skills they learned in class.

The students built an attractive large welcome center counter with wood side paneling, solid oak trims, locking doors and Pirate green Formica top. The counter is wired with multiple electrical outlets and Ethernet connections for convenient computer hookups. The center is located in the front main lobby of the high school and serves as the point of welcome for guests visiting the school. Here, visitors will sign in before proceeding to other points in the building. Prior to this project, security personnel greeted guests at a makeshift desk.

The Pattonville Technology Education home construction classes build projects of all types, ranging from complete single or two-story homes to smaller projects like the welcome center.
