Schools in the Pattonville School District will be hosting a series of one-hour “Building Blocks” community meetings designed to study and prioritize needs associated with improving and repairing district schools.

The Pattonville School District is in the process of developing a new facilities plan to address the future maintenance and repair needs of its schools. Except for Drummond Elementary, all of Pattonville’s other schools are between 35 to 51 years old. Parents, staff and community residents are encouraged to come to their neighborhood schools on the following dates to assist in identifying and setting priorities for ways to improve their school buildings through this new facilities plan. - **Holman Middle School** - 7 p.m., Feb. 15 (Participants can tour building at 6:30 p.m.)
- **Pattonville Heights Middle School** - 7 p.m., Feb. 13
- **Pattonville High School** - 6:30 p.m., Feb. 21
