Pattonville Council of PTAs forum for school board candidates to be aired on cable

A "Meet the Candidates" forum to be hosted by the Pattonville Council of PTAs for candidates to the Pattonville school board will be aired several times on area cable channels as a service to Pattonville voters.

During the event, Pattonville High School Social Studies Teacher Kevin Beckner will serve as moderator while several social studies students ask questions of the board candidates. The event will be produced by the Pattonville High School Pirate TV class in the class' TV studio and will air numerous times on Pattonville's Cable America channel, as well as the Cooperating School District's channel on Charter Cable.

The one-hour show will be aired at the following times and dates on both Charter Cable 21 and Cable America Channel 7:

- 4 p.m., Friday, March 30
- 10 a.m. and 3 p.m., Monday, April 2
- 10 a.m. and 3 p.m., Tuesday, April 3

The show will also air at 7 p.m., April 2 on the Cable America Channel. Voters who are unable to view the shows at these times are encouraged to record the show and view it at a later time. Voters without cable may check out a videotape of the forum beginning March 30 by calling (314) 213-8025.

Pattonville voters will elect two members to the Pattonville Board of Education on April 3. The following candidates, in order of filing, are on the ballot: Robert Dillon of St. Ann, Incumbent Ruth Petrov of Maryland Heights, and Sister Vincent Walz of Bridgeton.
