

Pattonville Heights named a top fund-raising school for cancer research

Pattonville Heights Middle School was named among the top three fund-raising schools in Missouri for cancer research. Students and staff at Pattonville Heights raised more than \$3,000 for cancer research after participating the Olive Garden's Pennies for Pasta, a program to raise funds for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society's School and Youth Campaign.

Students, staff and community members contributed change and other donations as part of the fund-raiser. Sixth-graders won recognition for raising the most funds - \$1,219.04 out of a total of \$3,051.27.
