

Drummond Elementary hosts International Day

Students and staff at Drummond Elementary School in the Pattonville School District recently learned about the world around them by participating in the school's International Day.

Each classroom studied a country that is represented by students attending Drummond. Teachers presented information about the culture, language and traditions of that country. Some teachers made PowerPoint presentations or videos for their classes, and some parents even joined in by sharing information about their native countries.

"We also had several parents volunteering to help as 'tour guides' and take students from class to class to visit other 'countries'," said Mary Binnington, an English Language Learner teacher at Drummond.
