A Roadmap to Success
for All Students



GOAL 1

Students demonstrate significant improvement in their understanding and application of state standards.

Missouri adopted a set of 73 standards that define what students should know and be able to do by the time they graduate from high school. These standards are designed to establish higher expectations for ALL Missouri students. Below are Pattonville's list of expectations for meeting these standards:

- All students are proficient in communication arts, mathematics and science.

Progress will be measured using results from the Missouri Assessment Program. The goal is for all students to score at the advanced or proficient levels.

- All students are responsible citizens.

Goals in this area are for student attendance to be 94 percent or higher, the dropout rate to be 3 percent or lower, schools to be safe and orderly, and for 100 percent of students to participate in community service.

- Technology use improves achievement and productivity.

Pattonville will implement its technology plan. The goal is that each year, the percentage of students who are technologically literate will increase, as measured on the technology census report to the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.

- Ninety percent of Pattonville graduates who sign an A+ agreement complete the A+ requirements or attend a four-year program.

An A+ partnership plan exists to support the A+ program.

- Vocational education is an integral component of the educational program.

The following will be increased: the number of Pattonville's vocational programs approved by the state, the number of students enrolled in vocational courses, the number of articulation agreements with post-secondary institutions, student participation in career and technical organizations and placement rates in post-secondary institutions.



GOAL 2

Schools will develop and implement building-level school improvement plans consistent with the district's plan.

School-based teams of parents and staff will develop, implement and update school improvement plans that focus on improving structure, instruction and climate. The plans should support improved student achievement and responsibility.

- Schools meet state and federal criteria for academic achievement.
- Climate improves annually or maintains a 90 percent satisfaction level.
- Teams are composed of at least 50 percent or more community/parent/student representatives who are not employees of the district.



GOAL 3

Pattonville will develop a plan that addresses critical issues.

Pattonville's plan will address changes in state funding, changes in enrollment, continued expansion of Lambert Airport, district staffing, safety, changes to the desegregation program and providing an updated facilities plan.

- A facilities plan will support student achievement.
- Pattonville will maintain the state's "desirable" student-teacher ratios within a balanced budget.
- Pattonville will provide a safe learning environment for students and staff.



Pattonville is fully accredited by the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and has been honored by the state for Distinction in Academic Performance.

Pattonville's Comprehensive School Improvement Plan has been deemed by the state as a model for Missouri (May 2003).
