WHAT IS REMINGTON TRADITIONAL SCHOOL?

- Remington Traditional School is a kindergarten through eighth grade school of choice.
- Remington Traditional is not an exclusive school. We enroll students throughout the entire Pattonville School District attendance area through an application basis and an open lottery.
- We are the only kindergarten through eighth grade public school in the St. Louis and St. Charles area.
- Since we offer a unique K-8 structure, our staff is able to provide students with a safe, consistent, and structured learning community. Our staff also has the opportunity to develop special relationships with each student as they learn and grow each year at Remington Traditional School. This is the heart of what makes us a “traditional” school.
- All of our K-8 teachers integrate curricular subject areas together. **This integration allows teachers to challenge students and develop higher level thinking skills. Reading and writing skills are integrated in Communication Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.**
- We offer two classes per grade level and a full day kindergarten.
- In grades six through eight we follow a middle school teaming approach.
- Pattonville School District provides bus transportation to and from school regardless of where you live within the district. Transportation for after-school activities is provided by parents.

School Hours: 8:05AM – 2:55PM, Monday through Friday.

STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

Our main focus at Remington Traditional School is on individual student academic achievement. Our staff monitors each student's growth and customizes instruction based on individual student needs.

- We follow the K-8 curriculum approved by the Pattonville School District and meet the educational requirements as outlined by the state of Missouri.
- Art, Vocal Music, Physical Education, Library-Media, and Computer Technology classes are provided for all students K-8.
- Gifted Education K-8 is provided for those students who qualify.
- Daily band and orchestra are offered for children in Grades 6-8. Daily orchestra is offered for Grade 5.
- A variety of after school clubs and activities form throughout the school year for grades K-8.
- Official progress reports in Kindergarten through Grade 8 are shared at the 2nd and 3rd trimesters with report cards given at each trimester.
- Parent Teacher conferences are held after the 1st and 2nd trimester for grades K-8.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

- Remington follows the board approved Pattonville Elementary and Middle School behavior guides when addressing discipline issues.
- Our staff incorporates the PBIS program to promote exemplary citizenship, caring relationships, and high expectations.
- We strive to provide a safe, friendly, challenging, engaging, and orderly learning environment. We do this through specific school-wide procedures, routines, and our Remington Traditional Role Model Character Program.

PARENT INVOLVEMENT AT REMINGTON TRADITIONAL SCHOOL

Parent Involvement is a key to student success. Here at Remington Traditional School your involvement is valued, encouraged, and necessary in the following ways:

- Support students with homework and daily classroom assignments.
- Talk with your child each day about their progress and provide positive encouragement and feedback.
- Check homework folders and/or daily planners on a daily basis.
- Communicate with staff about social or academic concerns.
- Attend parent-teacher conferences.
- Attend evening functions and school-wide activities.
- Support and reinforce with your children the district and school discipline and dress code guidelines.
- Join PTO and attend the monthly meetings.
- Communicate with our staff on a regular basis.
- Volunteer work and support in the classroom.

ENROLLMENT PROCESS FOR REMINGTON TRADITIONAL SCHOOL

Who is eligible?

- Children must be of school age to attend. (kindergarten must be 5 by July 31, 2015)
- Students must reside within the Pattonville School District, or be in a Special School District program housed here at Remington.
- Any educational plans developed by the previous school will be maintained and followed.
- Students with Individualized Education Plans that require a level of programming not offered at Remington will attend their home school.
- English Language Learners receive services through their regular classroom teacher. Remington is not assigned a certified E.L.L. teacher.

HOW ARE STUDENTS SELECTED?

- Students presently enrolled and attending Remington Traditional School must re-register by February 6, 2015.
- New applications are accepted until March 6, 2015 in order to be included in the lottery on April 7, 2015.
- New applications are randomly drawn in the lottery at 6:00pm on April 7, 2015 to fill any openings that remain after re-registration is completed. Students whose applications are received after these dates will be placed on a waiting list.
- Drawing of one's brother or sister in the lottery does not guarantee acceptance of siblings into Remington Traditional School.
- Families whose children have been selected in the lottery will be notified in writing by April 17, 2015.
- Students that are not selected during the lottery will be placed on a waiting list for the 1st trimester.
- Names from the waiting list will be drawn as openings occur until December 1, 2015.
