

Comprehensive School Improvement Plan Update

2017-2018

Meeting Minutes

Purpose: The Pattonville School District is working with parents, students, community members, staff and area leaders to update its strategic plan with a series of CSIP (Comprehensive School Improvement Plan) meetings during the 2017-2018 school year. The updated plan will focus on ensuring all students become "success-ready graduates" and planning for and addressing any critical issues that may arise in the areas of facilities, safety, staffing and finances.

Committee: Student Achievement

Committee task: Design a Pk-12 competency-based, personalized learning environment that leads to high school course content readiness and success ready graduates.

Committee problem statements:

1. How do we ensure all students are prepared to master high school course content?
2. How do we ensure all students are success ready graduates?

Date of Meeting: Sept. 5, 2017

Minutes from meeting:

- Committee members introduced themselves.
- Reviewed the process and goals of the committee. The main function of the committee is to create strategies and action steps to support the problem statements associated with student achievement (see above).
- Committee members completed a personalized learning quiz. The quiz focused on the district's vision, transparency in teaching and learning, culture, and personalized learning.
- Reviewed the elements of personalized learning and competency-based learning.
- Committee members participated in a group activity related to competency-based learning.

Work/research to be completed prior to next meeting:

- Committee members are reading two articles in preparation for the November 15 meeting (*Let's Celebrate Personalization, but not too fast and A New Kind of Classroom, No Grades, No Failing, No Hurry*).
